Beauty Therapy Level 1 Diploma – 1 Year

Entry Requirements

You require a minimum of 4 GCSEs at grade 9 – 2 including English Language and Maths.

What will I learn on this course?

This programme is designed to give you all the skills and knowledge required to learn the basic beauty therapy treatments and services delivered within the professional beauty industry.

The course will cover topics including:

- Professional nail treatments, manicure and pedicure, nail art services
- Makeup techniques and themed face painting
- Skin care and facials
- Creating a beauty image on a model for a photo shoot
- Photo shoots and fashion shows

What will this course lead on to?

Successful completion of this course could lead on to a Level 2 programme or employment as an assistant in a beauty salon.

Professional Beauty Therapy Level 2 Diploma – 1 Year

Entry Requirements

You require a minimum of 4 GCSEs or equivalent at grade 9 – 3 including English Language and Maths.

What will I learn on this course?

You will learn all the professional beauty treatments and services in our industry salons which include:

- Manicure and pedicure techniques
- Nail art designs
- Makeup skills
- Tanning
- Skincare and facials
- Waxing and lash and brow treatments, including individual lash application

What will this course lead on to?

Successful completion of this course could lead on to Level 3 Advanced Beauty Therapy or employment in a beauty salon or cosmetic company.

Professional Beauty Therapy Advanced Technical Diploma – Level 3

Entry Requirements

Completion of Level 2 in Beauty, plus a minimum of GCSE Grade 9 – 3 including English Language and Maths. You may need to attend an interview or complete a trade test.

What will I learn on this course?

- Facial and body electrical treatments
- Microdermabrasion
- Body massage and stone therapy massage
- Anatomy and physiology
- Body electrotherapy treatments
- Organise events and learn how to sell products and services

What will this course lead on to?

Successful completion of this course could lead to a career as a beauty therapist in a salon or on a cruise ship. Progression onto a teaching or training qualification (depending on experience) or self-employment.
