Hairdressing Level 1 Diploma – 1 Year

Entry Requirements

You require a minimum of 4 GCSEs at grade 9 – 2 including English Language and Maths.

What will I learn on this course?

The course will cover topics including:

- Shampoo and conditioning hair
- · Blow drying and styling
- Dressing long hair
- · Plaiting hair
- Basic colouring techniques
- Create a hair and beauty image by taking part in a fashion shoot or fashion show

What will this course lead on to?

Successful completion of this course could lead on to a Level 2 programme or employment as an assistant in a hairdressing salon.

Professional Hairdressing Level 2 Diploma – 1 Year

Entry Requirements

You require a minimum of 4 GCSE's or equivalent at grade 9 – 3 including English Language and Maths.

What will I learn on this course?

The course will cover topics including:

- Shampooing and conditioning treatments
- A variety of cutting techniques for long and short hair
- Barbering skills
- The art of dressing hair
- Introduction to hair colouring techniques from basic root application to specialist foil work

What will this course lead on to?

Successful completion of this course can lead to progression onto the Level 3 Hairdressing qualification or employment as a junior stylist within a salon.

Professional Hairdressing Advanced Technical Diploma – Level 3

Entry Requirements

Completion of Level 2 in Beauty, plus a minimum of GCSE Grade 9 – 3 including English Language and Maths. You may need to complete a trade test.

What will I learn on this course?

The course will cover topics including:

- The course consists of written assignments/tasks/tests and practical assessments
- Creative competition work
- Advanced cutting techniques
- The dressing of hair to create "high fashion" designs, and artistic colouring methods
- Organisation of promotional activities and events

What will this course lead on to?

You could progress to work as a stylist in a salon, salon management, self-employment or a Higher Education Level 4 Hairdressing qualification.
