Makeup Artistry with Hairdressing Level 1 Diploma – 1 Year

Entry Requirements

You require a minimum of 4 GCSEs at grade 9 – 2 including English Language and Maths.

What will I learn on this course?

The course will cover topics including:

- Skincare preparation
- Natural glow makeup
- Contouring and highlighting
- Brow enhancement
- Day and evening makeup
- Introduction to catwalk makeup and special effects makeup
- A variety of hairdressing techniques to complement your fashion makeup looks
- Take part in a fashion shoot

What will this course lead on to?

Successful completion of this course could lead to progression on to Level 2 Diploma in Media Makeup or a career as an makeup assistant within a salon or makeup counter.



Professional Hair and Media Makeup Level 2 Technical Certificate – 1 Year

Entry Requirements

You require a minimum of 4 GCSE's or equivalent at grade 9 – 3 including English Language and Maths.

What will I learn on this course?

The course will cover topics including:

- The application of creative, fashion and photographic makeups
- An introduction to the foundations of special effects, body art design
- Lash and brow treatment
- Individual lash application
- The art of dressing short and long hair
- Basic hair colouring techniques and creating a fashion image based on a theme

What will this course lead on to?

Successful completion of this course can lead to progression to the Level 3 Theatrical, Fashion & Special Effects Makeup course or employment within the industry, working for cosmetic fashion houses or working as a makeup artist in a salon or work as a freelance makeup artist.

Professional Theatrical and Media Makeup Advanced Technical Diploma – Level 3

Entry Requirements

Successful completion of Level 2 Media Makeup plus a minimum of GCSE grade 9 – 4 in English Language and Maths.

What will I learn on this course?

The course will cover topics including:

- Style and fit postiche/wigs
- Create high fashion and catwalk make up looks
- Apply camouflage make up
- Monitor and maintain health and safety practice in the salon
- Apply airbrush make up
- Complete photographic make up looks
- Create and apply prosthetic pieces and bald caps
- Design and apply face and body art and style hair to complement makeup looks
- Advanced body art
- Special effects makeup for TV and film

What will this course lead on to?

Successful completion of this course can lead to higher level and degree courses in Advanced fashion or prosthetics/ special effects make up. Employment within the industry in Photographic studios, TV, film,
