Plumbing Level 1 Diploma - 1 Year

Entry Requirements

Four GCSEs Grade 9 – 2, including Maths and English Language.

What will I learn on this course?

The course will cover topics including:

- Prepare different materials for use in the plumbing process
- Understand different types of plumbing systems and fittings
- Fit systems in a workshop setting
- Safe working practices, information
- Quantities and communication with others
- Building methods and construction
- Erect and dismantle working platforms

What will this course lead on to?

The successful completion of this course could lead to progression to a Level 2 Diploma or possible apprenticeship programme.

Plumbing Level 2 Diploma - 1 Year

Entry Requirements

Four GCSEs Grade 9 – 3 including Maths and English Language. Or the completion of a Level 1 Diploma in Plumbing.

What will I learn on this course?

The course will cover topics including:

- Health and Safety in building services
- Hot water
- Cold water
- Electrical principles
- Central heating systems
- Sanitation
- Plumbing maintenance
- Bathroom installation

You will also have the opportunity to take part in internal and external competitions at regional and national events.

What will this course lead on to?

The successful completion of this course could lead to a Level 3 Plumbing or possible apprenticeship programme.

Plumbing Level 3 Diploma - 1 Year

Entry Requirements

You must have successfully completed Level 2 Diploma Plumbing and GCSE Grade 4 or Level 2 in English and Maths.

What will I learn on this course?

The course will cover topics including:

- Complex hot and cold-water systems
- Sanitation, central heating and gas installation
- Install and commission systems
- Fit systems in a workshop setting and check that operate correctly and efficiently
- Fault find and diagnose system faults
- There is an amount of electrical knowledge required to complete the course at Level 3
- Studies include the relevant legislation including, gas, electrical, building regulations.
 You will also study the codes of practice that must be adhered by people working within the industry

What will this course lead on to?

The course is designed as an advanced level that will teach the skills and processes required to pursue a career in Plumbing as an apprentice or trainee plumber. It builds on the Level 2 Plumbing Qualification and it supports the requirements that are needed to complete a plumbing apprenticeship.
