The school has achieved excellent results over the years, with high pass rates in all A level and Vocational subjects and excellent ALPS scores across most courses. The Creative and Performing Arts team has an extremely high profile in the College and is dedicated to continuously addressing areas for improvement and building on strengths.

The school offers a wide variety of enrichment activities including educational visits and guest speakers. We have previously enjoyed trips to New York, The Netherlands, Paris, Venice, Barcelona and London and the department is also involved with ongoing projects with local schools and regularly performs in venues across the region.

In 2019 we opened our brand new contemporary theatre with state of the art technology providing students within the Centre of Excellence for Performing Arts a cutting edge performance space. The theatre has a diverse and accommodating stage area with an orchestra pit allowing for more sizeable and challenging productions.



In September 2026 we will be opening our new music accommodation. The new music build houses a fully-equipped recording studio, 3 band rooms, 3 practice rooms a performance teaching space and two classrooms equipped with Macs running Logic.

The recording studio hosts a state of the art Audient mixing desk, along with studio monitors and a Mac running Logic. The space links directly with band rooms 1 and 2 allowing for multi-track recording. The department has a range of microphones for use to support students in developing their recording skills.

The performance space has stage lighting and its own sound system for intimate lunchtime performances and rehearsals. The space provides the opportunity to develop live sound skills.

The practice rooms are equipped with a piano keyboard for instrumental lessons and independent practice.

The classrooms are equipped with Macs running Logic to give students the opportunity to mix and master the tracks they have recorded in the studio, alongside building websites and completing

written work for the course.
