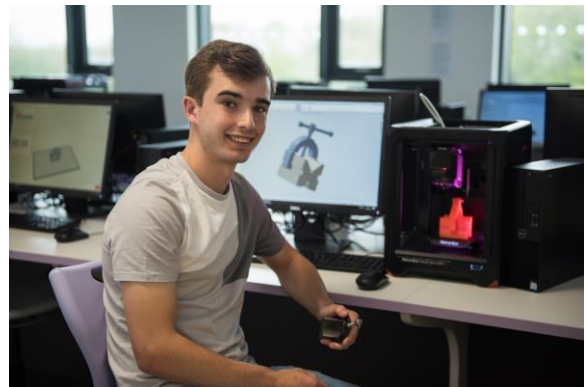

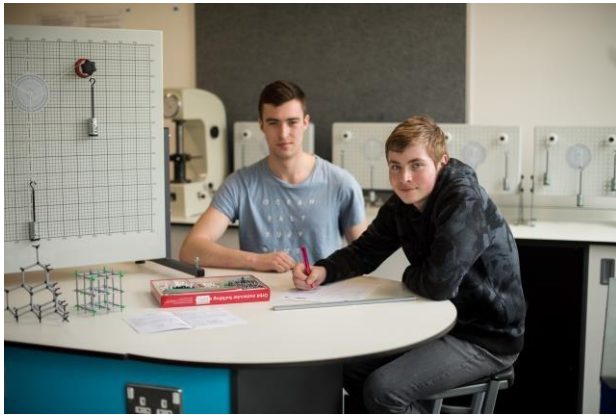

Studying Engineering or the Digital Built Environment at Cranton Sixth Form College opens a variety of opportunities to students aiming for a new and exciting career in today's high technology society. The programmes are delivered in the IDEA Centre which, in addition to high quality teaching rooms, also boasts state of the art CAD workshops, electronics and metrology labs, with manufacturing workshops to provide hands on training and development in Robotics, Pneumatics and Hydraulics, Microelectronics and Engineering applications.

Students can also work on a simulated manufacturing process line and resistant materials lab to experience the very latest technology in engineering processes and digital built environment methods of working. The department offers a wide variety of enrichment activities, including Karting competitions and a highly successful 'Women in STEM Programme' which provides students with outstanding opportunities to engage in competitions and industry projects and receive excellent mentoring. Furthermore, the department offers national and international trips, where students are given the opportunity to enhance their study within their vocation, making the topics realistic and enabling students to relate them to the real world. Students are visited by guest speakers from various organisations and public services, who often set workshops and assignments based on current issues throughout the curriculum areas. Close links have been made with many local universities, including the Universities of Liverpool, Manchester, Salford, Liverpool John Moores and Manchester Metropolitan University.

The Department has excellent relationships with local, regional and national employers. Some examples being; Carpenter additives, Balfour Beatty, Sigmatech, Kier Construction, Jaguar Land Rover, People's Ford, Glen Dimplex and MITIE. The college was actively involved in meeting the skills needs for the Mersey Gateway project, a £600m construction project which delivered a new six lane toll bridge over the River Mersey and provided 4,640 new jobs to the area.
